

Animal Care Technician

The technician will need to perform technical rodent skills such as handling, along with assisting with health monitoring technical procedures.

Excellent oral communication skills. Able to work with an NSG Breeding colony. Able to pick up 50 pounds. Perform other duties as assigned.
